

NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN THAT Pomona Valley Transportation Authority (PVTA) is applying for funding through the FTA 5310 program to:

- 1) Purchase replacement paratransit vehicles through the FTA Section 5310 program. Services shall be open to all elderly and disabled persons for \$1 fare for travel anywhere within the cities of Claremont, La Verne, Pomona and San Dimas. Service operates Mon - Fri 6:00 a.m. - 7:30 p.m. Saturday 8:30 a.m. - 5:00 p.m. & Sunday 7:30 a.m. - 5:00 p.m. Services are also provided to destinations west of the four cities as far as Grand Avenue and to medical destinations in San Bernardino County for fares ranging from \$2 to \$12.
- 2) Operate mobility management services aiding riders and coordinating among public and other transportation providers in order to expand the availability of service. Services will include the operation of a transit store, a one-stop transportation call center to provide transportation information on all travel modes and manage eligibility requirements and arrangements for customers among participating programs.


As a requirement of the program, the PVTA Board of Directors will hold a PUBLIC HEARING to consider certifying that there are no nonprofit corporations readily available in the cities of Claremont, La Verne, Pomona and San Dimas to provide transportation services described above throughout the four cities of Claremont, La Verne, Pomona and San Dimas.

The public hearing will be held on February 8, 2023, at 5:00 p.m. in the Council Chambers of La Verne City Hall, 3660 D Street, La Verne, California at which all persons are invited to appear and be heard.
