

**NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING
PROPOSED SERVICE CHANGES:
CLAREMONT DIAL-A-RIDE FARE CHANGES FOR GENERAL PUBLIC ONLY
CLAREMONT DIAL-A-RIDE REDUCTION OF OPERATING HOURS**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the City of Claremont City Council will hold a public hearing on Tuesday, June 23, 2026 at 7:00 p.m. or as soon thereafter as the matter may be heard, in the City Council Chamber, 225 W. 2nd Street, to receive comments regarding proposed new Claremont Dial-a-Ride fares and operating hours.

Proposed Changes Effective September 1, 2026:

The City of Claremont and Pomona Valley Transportation Authority (PVTA) are proposing to modify the Claremont Dial-a-Ride (DAR) service as follows:

1. Increase General Public Fare

The Claremont Dial-a-Ride current General Public fare is \$2.50 within Claremont and \$4.00 outside city boundaries. The City of Claremont and PVTA are proposing to increase only the General Public fare to better align with increasing costs and containment strategies.

Fare Type	Current Fare	Proposed Fare
General Public <i>within</i> Claremont	\$2.50	\$4.50
General Public <i>outside</i> Claremont	\$4.00	\$7.00

2. Reduction in Operating Hours

Claremont Dial-a-Ride currently operates 24 hours per day, 7 days per week. The City of Claremont and PVTA are proposing to adjust the service hours to better align with rider demand and improve operational efficiency.

- **Current Service:** 24 hours per day, 7 days per week
- **Proposed Service:** Approximately **7:00 AM to 8:00 PM, 7 days per week**
